- **County Roundtables** – All board members were asked to give brief updates from their Counties, Cities, or SCD.
 - **City of Mott (Mosbrucker)**
 - The Cannonball Community Center, that was awarded through the Grid United funding is still a go, meeting is scheduled with DOE for next week
 - Streets in Mott are still tore up
 - Nursing home has 20 of 22 beds filled
 - **Dunn County (Sampsel)**
 - Broke ground on the new public safety building

- Killdeer has new golf simulator in the old fire department, lots of local businesses donated to it.
- Bronson's is operating in the old grocery store, new building is still a go.
- **Stark County (Jilek)**
 - New airport terminal is under construction
 - Lots of road construction
 - First concert of the summer happening today
 - Waiting to see what the presidential library brings
 - Lots of growth happening in Richardton
 - Stark Development purchased a new building
- **Slope-Hettinger SCD (Nielson)**
 - Doing a lot in youth education
 - New England is having an all-school reunion in July
 - Group trying to get New England Golf Course open again
- **Billings County (Klym)**
 - Focused on getting through the Library opening
 - There are a lot of locals leaving for the opening
- **Stark County (Messer)**
 - New airport terminal underway
 - New livestock building out at the fairgrounds
- **Golden Valley County (Farstveet)**
 - Beach started a water and sewer project, and they found layers of clay that is delaying work
- **Adams County (West)**
 - Having public input meetings whether to join the state 911 program, overwhelming looking to be in favor for changing the addressing system.
- **Stark-Billings SCD (Baar)**
 - Planting more trees than any other SCD in the state for the last four years
 - Working on funding for watershed project
 - State is pushing more grass seeding
- **City of Dickinson (Ridl)**
 - Road construction, roundabouts going in in the business loop
 - Museum expansion moving along
 - Waiting to see what the library opening brings, emergency declaration in place just in case
- **City of Killdeer (Fenstermaker)**
 - Working with the grocery store to determine location for new building
 - Feasibility study on a recreation center in Killdeer
 - Planning for a new city hall
- **Hettinger County (Laufer)**
 - Continuation of the construction in Regent.
- **City of Bowman (James)**
 - Opening bids for the remainder of the sewer project, then it will all be completed

- Received grant for water storage project
- Public private partnership with a builder building twin homes, four houses built, all sold
